Local Company Repeats as Top Plant Certification Award Winner

When the National Precast Concrete Association's (NPCA) annual Quality Award of Excellence winners were announced on Jan. 29, Modern Precast Concrete of Easton, Pa., received the top award for the second time since 2006.

The award was announced in Charlotte, N.C. at The Precast Show 2011, the largest trade show for the precast concrete industry. The award is presented to the four NPCA certified plants that recorded the highest inspection scores in the previous year.

NPCA plants that have been continuously certified for 5, 10, 15 and 20 years are honored for their long-term commitment to quality production practices. In addition, every year, the plants that earn the top 25 overall scores in the plant certification program are recognized. With nearly 400 plants in the NPCA certification program, the top 25 award, known as the Quality Award of Merit, represents the top 6 percent of all certified plants.

The top three overall scores are presented the Quality Award of Excellence, NPCA's highest quality award. The Quality Award of Excellence signifies that a plant has placed in the top 1 percent of all NPCA certified plants.
